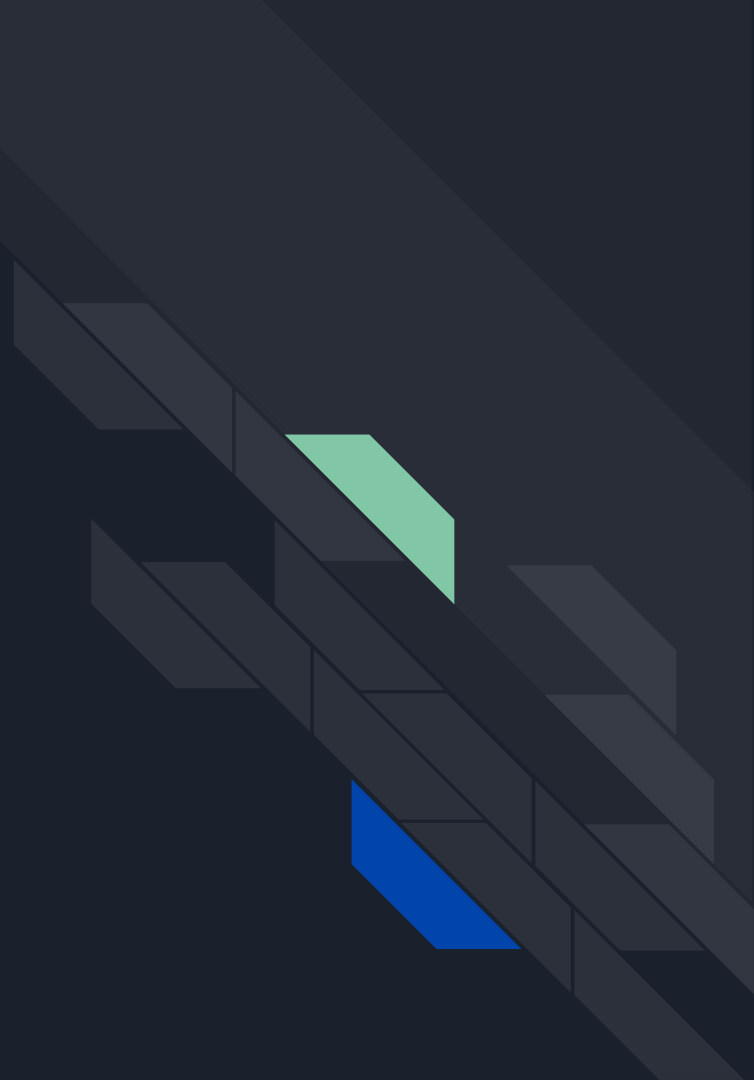
These are photos of us cutting the wood to construct the bog bridge, along with us bringing the bench to the viewpoint.
